Important notes:

- If a student is granted credit for previous studies, it will reduce the number of courses (units) required in the selected degree program at ANU. Any credit received will impact upon the choice of course/subject choices within ANU programs.
- It is the responsibility of the student to check when specific courses are offered at the ANU and to change their program study plan accordingly. More details can be found here: programsandcourses.anu.edu.au
- It is strongly recommended that students attend ANU Orientation Week or meet with an academic advisor to confirm their program study plan when commencing their studies at ANU.
- The above arrangements are correct as of June 2021 for a period of three years and are subject to change.
- Students must achieve a GPA 3.2/4.0, where 2.0/4.0 is a pass, in order to be eligible for admission and **up to** one year of credit.
- A minimum grade of GPA 2.75/4.0 or above is required per course for credit to be granted. If a student does not meet this entry requirement for a course, they will not receive credit for that particular course.
- A maximum of 8 courses or 48 units of credit will be granted towards the ANU program.
- Where more than one Ngee Ann course is equal to one or more ANU courses, students must take all courses specified in order to receive full credit.
- Bachelor of Commerce students who choose the Accounting major (8 courses) and would like professional accreditation will need to meet with an academic advisor to plan their program in order to be able to meet the major and professional requirements within the two year program.
- All applicants must meet standard ANU admissions requirements, including English Language Requirements, provided at anu.edu.au/study/apply/international-applications-undergraduate-and-postgraduate
- Each application for credit transfer will be assessed on an individual basis and the College will make the final decision.
